Research Plan

Elements of a Research Plan

- Each plan differs based on the complexity of the research question and resources available
- Check and refine your plan as you conduct your research
- Maintain a research log

2. Statement of legal issue(s)

3. Jurisdiction(s)

4. Potential sources and sequence

5. Search terms

6. Pragmatic factors: Deadline, time allocation, amount of resources
