Each lesson concentrates on a few selected SDGs, children's rights and a selected corpus of influential and/or significant children's literature from the geographical areas of the organising universities:



Milestones

A NOTED-funded 4-year project from 2022-2025

The project is a collaboration between Western Norway University of Applied Sciences (HVL), University of Padova (UNIPD), and Universitat Internacional de Catalunya (UIC). The students and staff involved in the project do all partake in 5-year MA programme in teacher education with an orientation in language and literature.

The project's main goals are to enhance the quality of education and strengthen international collaboration within the field of environmental children's literature and to increase student and staff mobility.

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
